The Mandurah Swimming Club Captains and Vice Captains will be selected by the Coaches and Committee in March each year and the positions presented at the Annual Awards Night in Late April early May.

The nominated Coach and Committee will talk to each member of the leadership group in the lead up to the decision to see how the member is developing and to see if they are planning to be available for a Leadership Role for the following 12 months.

The following Roles will be filled

- Female Club Captain
- Male Club Captain
- Female Vice Captain (up to 2 positions)
- Male Vice Captain (up to 2 positions)

The following selection criteria will be used by the Coaching Staff and Committee to choose the Leadership Group positions

- Look at leadership the swimmer exhibits around the club and squads
- Length of service with the club
- Maturity shown around the club
- Coaches feedback about behaviour at training
- Behaviour when representing the club at swim meets

The following roles are asked of our Leadership Group from the Coaches and Committee

- Provide the Coaches and Committee feedback from the swimmers, e.g. training sets/load, inappropriate behaviour, positive behaviour etc.
- Assist the Coaches and fellow Swimmers at meets and club functions
- Organise social gatherings of the swimmers/squads to build team moral (assistance is available from the Committee) e.g. movie night, social dinner, other ideas you have.
- Be a positive role model to other club swimmers and assist new members to join the squads
- Wear your club uniform and badge with pride around your Club and when representing your club.
- Minor tasks requested by the Coaching Staff or Committee as requested.
